and motivate young people struggling with mainstream education. We train them as bicycle mechanics and give them the opportunity to get out on mountain bike adventures. The pupils develop transferable skills which will enable them to succeed in the workplace

- To engage and motivate young people with the long term aim of equipping them with the necessary life skills to be successful in the workplace
- To increase young people's sense of social responsibility within their local community
- To encourage young people to live and enjoy a healthy lifestyle






Headline Figures

- # 400 bikes recycled a year
- 21 young people assisted every year with 234 hours support each
- Our young people gain practical skills: 100% achieved a basic Bicycle Maintenance qualification. 86% went on to achieve AQA Level 1 and over HALF achieve AQA Level 2
- 57% of young people go on to further education and/or training with a THIRD going on to voluntary or paid work
- 600 bikes donated yearly to Bikespace
- 160 kids bikes given free to people in disadvantaged communities
- We have created **FIVE** full time equivalent jobs to date



Case study: Marcus

Marcus was a pupil at Bikespace one day per week. He achieved ASDAN awards in English and Maths. He then went on to complete a Customer Service Apprenticeship and is now about to complete his NVQ Level 2 Bicycle Mechanics. This shows the potential for pupils to progress through Bikespace.





Plans for the future

- Bikespace has taken on a new shop in Devonport in Plymouth selling electric bikes - we want to develop this and encourage more people to cycle
- We are developing a business to business delivery service using electric cargo bikes
- We want to continue to expand our work supporting young people in the city
- We want to provide job opportunities for vulnerable adults such as ex-offenders and those on rehab programmes
- We aim to increase awareness of sustainable transport in Plymouth
